

BIENNALE " LE LATITUDINI DELL'ARTE" 2nd edition HUNGARY and ITALY

Sunday, July 12, 2015, 18.30, at Palazzo Ducale in the hall of Munizioniere, will be inaugurated the second edition of the Biennial of Contemporary Art: "Le latitudini dell'arte".

The exhibition, curated by ART Commission – organization for social promotion of culture, in collaboration with Palazzo Ducale Foundation for Culture and the Consulate of Hungary in Genoa, was born with the aim to promote the artistic and cultural exchange between Italy and other countries.

After Finland, the protagonist of the first edition, in 2015, the choice fell on another European country of strong artistic traditions - Hungary.

Seventy artists will take part in the exhibition, 35 Hungarian and 35 Italian, the event is curated, for Hungary by Márta Simonffy, director of the Hungarian Artist Association of Figurative and Applied Arts in Budapest, and for Italy by Virginia Monteverde, president of Art Commission, creator and curator of the event. Critical presentation curated by Viana Conti.
